The KÖNIGSCARD is not available for over-the-counter purchase. You will receive your card directly from your host when you check in at your accommodation.

How does the KÖNIGSCARD work?

With the KÖNIGSCARD you can take advantage of as many offers as you like for free.

For easy planning of your vacation, you will receive this experience guide in which you will find all the royal experiences. Each person staying with the KÖNIGSCARD host receives their own KÖNIGSCARD.



How often can I benefit?

Depending on the services offered, we distinguish between 2 different usage variants:

1x per day - The service offer can be used once every day of your stay

1x per week - If you are on vacation for more than one week with the KÖNIGSCARD, this service can be used a second time from the 8th overnight stay, a third time from the 15th overnight stay and so on.

Please note:
Only one service per day can be used within the mountain railroad, ski trip and bathing areas.

Example: After using a cable car, the next cable car can only be used on the following day. The combination of cable car, boat trip and swimming is possible on the same day, for example.

Opening hours, dates and usage options can be found under the respective service. Some services can only be used once a week, e.g. e-bike rental.

When is the KÖNIGSCARD valid?

The KÖNIGSCARD is valid from 12.00 noon on the day of arrival until 12.00 on the day of departure.

It is not available over the counter, but only from our host partner businesses.

In the event of card misuse, the card will be withdrawn and a report will be made.

It is only valid with a clearly legible first name and surname.

The scope of the service may be limited due to weather and operating conditions (e.g. the capacity of a business may have been reached or the bikes at the bike rental shop may all be taken).




All the imposing Bavarian royal castles - whether fairy-tale like Neuschwanstein and Hohenschwangau or fortress-like like Falkenstein, Freyberg and Eisenberg - are located in the Ostallgäu region, the part of the Allgäu where the KÖNIGSCARD is at home.

Free travel by bus and train
