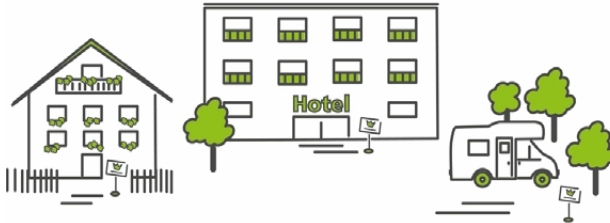

How often can I claim benefits?

Depending on the services offered, we distinguish between 2 different usage variants:

1x per day - The service offer can be used 1x per day of your stay.

1x per week - If you are on vacation with the KÖNIGSCARD, this service can be used from the 7th overnight stay a 2nd time, from the 14th overnight stay a 3rd time and so on.

Please note:

Within the areas of mountain railroad, shipping and bathing, only one service per day can be used.

Example: After using a mountain railroad, the next mountain railroad can only be used on the following day. However, the combination of mountain railroad, boat trip and bathing is possible, for example.

Dates and usage options can be found at the respective service. Some services can only be used once a week, e.g. e-bike rental.

In the BADEHAUS of Waldram (formerly Föhrenwald), history can be experienced as if in fast motion: from 1940, the National Socialists built a model settlement for armaments workers in the Wolfratshaus forest. Towards the end of the war, the concentration camp death march passed by here. Then Föhrenwald became a camp for Jewish displaced persons who had survived the Holocaust. From 1956 on, mostly Catholic displaced persons with many children were settled and the place was renamed Waldram. To this day you can find here

Traces of this unique migration history. It is told vividly and in multimedia form in the newly built BADEHAUS place of remembrance. A citizens' initiative saved the building from demolition and built a place of remembrance, encounter and learning there.
